Some common misconceptions

You will receive an offer at your nearest school

You will get a place at one of the schools you name on the form

You have a better chance of an offer if you place the school highest on the application form

Your child has special needs and will get a place at your first choice school

Your child has a medical or social reason and will get a place at your first choice school

The application process

The application is made in the borough where you live and pay council tax

You can apply for other boroughs

You can name up to 6 schools on the application form

All preferences are treated equally

Put your preferences in the order you most wish your child to receive a place at

Application Criteria

- Church attendance
- Aptitude tests for music and arts
- Banding tests
- Attendance at certain primary feeder schools
- Distance
