School closure

Following the government's announcement yesterday, schools in England and Wales will close except for looking after the children of key workers and vulnerable children.

We have also learned that all tests and exams will be cancelled, including Y6 SATs.

In this difficult time, we want to do all we can to support families who are vulnerable, hungry and in most need of support. Staff will continue to work at school wherever possible but we are under increasing strain with reducing staffing levels and have not got the capacity to look after every child. Please complete the slip below or give us a ring today if you believe you need to access childcare at school next week. We will inform parents this Friday if we can accept your child next week.

From Monday 23rd March school will be <u>closed to most children</u> until further notice and families will need to make provision for them at home.
